Bringing parents into the process:

Faith formation that lasts a lifetime!

- Our approach is driven by the idea that we should **coach parents** to form their own children. They become catechists.
- Your role in the faith formation of children in your parish remains a very important one. You now **become the coach** to assist, empower, teach, and cheer on the parents to play their role better.

Resources in this Document

This document outlines resources to help you apply this model through the different stages of the faith formation process.

🙀 Baptism & Young Families

Baptism preparation can be frustrating for both the leader and the participants. Parents often don't want to be there and may see it as a waste of time. What if we used this as an opportunity to engage parents around this this new stage in their lives and evangelize them?

Growing Up Catholic Baptism Preparation

- Focuses on evangelizing parents and deepening their faith.
- Helps parents **step into this amazing new role**. *Start coaching them from the beginning.*
- Speaks to parents **where they are at**, starting from their current experience, both joys and struggles.
- A **welcoming process** that reaches out to non-Catholic spouses and less-active Catholics.



- **Discussion-based** sessions built around faith journey, the Paschal Mystery in daily life & parenting, and connection to the larger Church community.
- Designed to be **flexible**. It can be used in the recommended three session format or in onesession or two-session variations.
- Delivered as **reproducible** PDF and editable Word files, including leader guide, worksheets, FAQs and handouts.

During the period after baptism, many families lose connection with their parish. Their children are fidgety at Mass and the stresses of parenting a young child make it difficult for them to prioritize their faith. This is a time when the Church needs to reach out to stay in touch.

Post-Baptism Resources & Tools


- After the Plunge is a series of seasonal letters and leaflets.
- Stay connected to your young parents through quarterly **mailings**, using this resource as the starting point.
- Offer something meaningful and relevant to these young families.

Sacramental Preparation

Preparation for these sacraments is a wonderful time to start really involving parents. As leaders, you have a little more leverage, since parents expect to be involved in some way (and they want their children to receive these sacraments). Bring them into the process and teach them their role. Then they'll be ready for more.

Growing Up Catholic First Eucharist, First Reconciliation, and Confirmation (in Restored Order)

- **Designed to coach parents.** This brings them into the process and makes them the teachers of their own children.
- Uses handouts instead of textbooks. Textbooks are intimidating. Handouts empower parents, help children learn, and keep costs down. Children, parents, and leaders each get their own.




- **Brings faith home.** We emphasize at-home activities that extend faith into the household and will make faith last a lifetime.

Confirmation Preparation

When we prepare older youth for confirmation, we often automatically assume that parents won't be significantly involved. But this is such an important time to encourage families to talk about their faith together. Parents and their children can learn side-by-side and really start engaging these issues on an adult level.

Family Catechesis

Ongoing faith formation is traditionally focused on just the children, but we now know that their faith is very unlikely to last if their parents are not engaged in their faith and the process. We offer a variety of resources to involve parents.

Growing Up Catholic Whole Family & Parent Catechesis

This resource works alongside your current curriculum, reinforcing the learning with the whole family.

- Sessions for 11 core topics found in all major Catholic curriculums and the CCC.
- Schedule one **whole family** session for each module in your regular curriculum, when parents and children can learn side-by-side.
- Parents meet for **parent catechesis** while their children are in class, on special parent evenings, or as part of a PTA meeting.

- Special attention is paid to non-Catholic parents, families with children in more than one age group, and households not regularly active in parish life.
